1015 - 1045	Shelling continues of all areas of DUBROVNIK UNICEF officials, The three Croatian Ministers, International Red Cross officials, MI'50, three volunteer secretaries/translators, other guests, hotel staff and monitors have been gathered in the bar and OPS-room since early morning. The moral is good. Everybody has got patience and a good sense of humour. It is burning in many places in the old city	
1045 - 1100	Frequency is now 15 heavy shells pr minute with some minutes interval	
1100	Now it is really burning in the old town. Frequency is slowing down again	
1110	Minister Rudolf talking to Zagreb. Message from Bokar-torska Naval Base. JNA will cease fire at 1115 hours. A meeting in CAVTAR is planned for 1330 hours. Inch ALLAH.	
1115	CF effective for four minutes	
1119	From this time the frequency dropped considerably.

Shelling still in progress. The apology was certainly of great value ???"	Forward to Split
