The World Heritage Committee,

- Having examined Documents WHC-06 30.COM 8B and WHC-06 30 COMINF.HBJ, and recalling Decision 30 COM 8B.53 on the extension of the Decani Monastery to include the Patriarchate of Pet Monastery, Gracanica Monastery and the Church of the Virgin of Ljevisa, Serbia,
- 2. <u>Notes</u>, in compliance with Article 11.4 of the Convention concerning the protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage and *Operational Guidelines*, paragraph 179, and in conformity with Decision 29 **COM** 7C,
 - a) The need for a legal statusfor the protection of the property;
 - b) The I ack of I egi si ati ve protecti on of buffer zones;
 - c) The I ack of implementation of the management pi an and of active management;
 - The difficulties to monitor the property due to political instability, post-conflict situation (visits under the Kosovo Stabilization Force/United Nations interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (KFOR/UNMIK) escort and lack of guards and security);
 - e) The unsatisfactory state of conservation and maintenanceof theproperty.
- 3. <u>Inscribes</u> the **Medieval Monuments in Kosovo, Serbia**, on the List of World Heritage in Danger in order to all ow international support to address the following benchmarks:
 - a) Full and permanent protection of the property under secure and stable political environment;
 - b) Agreed medium-term plan for the restoration of wall paintings (including preventive conservation regime) and conservation and rehabilitation of the properties; and
 - c) ! mpl ementati on of the management pi arts, and f ul l establ i shment of buffer zones and boundari es i nc! udi ng the r l egal protecti on.
- 4. Requests the State Party, in conformity with Committee Decision 29 **COM** 7C, in cooperation with UNESCO programes, UNMIK and Provisional Institutions of Self Government in Kosovo, to take the following urgent / short-term corrective measures by the end of 2006:
 - a) Rjt in place appropriate guarding and security arrangements for the Church of the Virgin of Ljevisa;
 - b) Prepare a conservation status report including a condition survey for the wall paint ings and the status of the conservation works and take temporary measures where there is an urgent need (for example the lead roof of the west bay of the nave of the Church of Virgin of Ljevisa, that was partily removed, etc.);
 - c) Repare a risk preparedness study, in conformity with *Operational Guidelines* paragraph 118 and Decision **28COM 10B.4**;
- 5. <u>Also requests</u> the State Party, in cooperation with UNESCO programs, UNMIK and R-ovisional Institutions of Self Government in Kosovo, to take the following long-term corrective measures:
 - a) Ensure the adequate i ong-term I egi si ati ve, regul atory protect! on and management of the property, in conformity with *Operational Guidelines*

paragraph 97;

- b) FUt i n pi ace strong protecti ve regi mes for the buffer zones;
- c) Adequately delineate the boundaries (eg. extend the boundaries of the Patharchate of Pec to i nclude more of its ri versi de-val I ey setts ngs);
- d) Prepare detailed state of conservation reports as a basis for adapted monitoring, preventive conservation measures, and specific conservation projects to reverse decline:
- e) Ensure appropriate and timely implementation of the Management R an.
